RE: 2011 Crop Year Renewal Notifications

Dear AGENCY:

The Federal Crop Insurance Corporation (FCIC) released a new Common Crop Insurance Policy Basic Provisions and related crop provisions that will be the basis for insurance coverage starting with the 2011 crop year. The new policy combines the Actual Production History (APH), Crop Revenue Coverage (CRC), Revenue Assurance (RA), Income Protection (IP) and Indexed Income Protection (IIP) policies into a single policy. You do not need to do a thing to continue your coverage for the 2011 crop year. ProAg will be sending letters to one or more of your policyholders explaining the changes to their policies for 2011, advising them that this is an automatic transition and directing them to your office if they have questions or need to make changes to their current policy. **POLICY WILL AUTOMATICALLY CONVERT:** The crop insurance policy is a continuous contract; therefore, the policy will renew and automatically convert to the coverage most similar to the type of policy the insured had last year. If the insured does not wish to make changes to their crop insurance policy for the 2011 crop year, then no additional paperwork is required. The chart provided below describes how the insured's 2010 policy will be converted to the new policy for the 2011 crop year. Both yield and revenue protection policies are available for the 2011 crop year under the new Basic Provisions and related crop provisions for wheat, barley, malting barley, corn, grain sorghum, soybeans, cotton, rice, sunflowers and canola/rapeseed.

Revenue Assurance (RA) with the Fall Harvest Price Option	»	Revenue Protection Plan
Revenue Assurance (RA) without the Fall Harvest Price Option	»	Revenue Protection Plan with the Harvest Price Exclusion
Actual Production History (APH) (includes CAT endorsement)	»	Yield Protection Plan
